Wellness

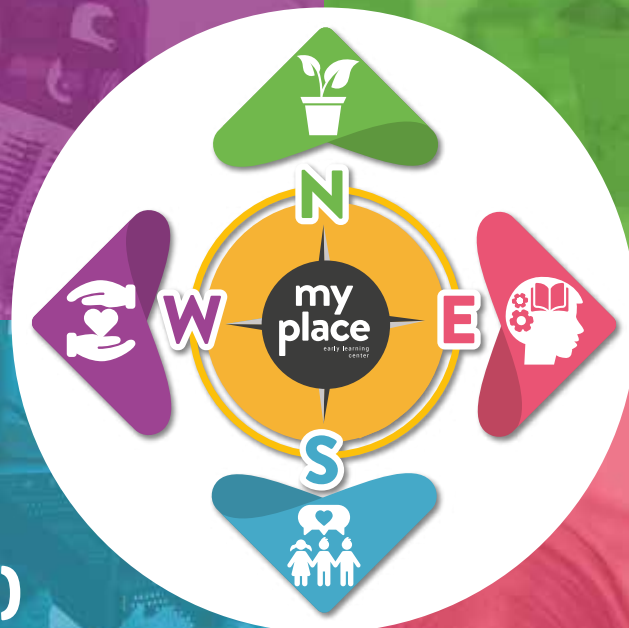
NUTRITION, EXERCISE & SAFETY

WHAT IS STEAM?

STEAM is an acronym that stands for **Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Mathematics**. Our STEAM based curriculum explores all concepts through picture and nonfiction books, hands-on activities, and project-based learning. **We are teaching our students that science is a way of thinking through observation, asking questions, and experiments.** We utilize technology as a tool and not a dependency as we become inventive and learn how things work. Engineering teaches children to solve problems, design, and create with different materials. Our curriculum also explores art, math, and so much more.

OUR PROGRAMS

INFANT A

6 weeks - 6 months

The infant A program is designed to maximize your child's cognitive, physical and emotional development. It incorporates stimulating activities, with an atmosphere of caring, love and hugs, giving teachers fun activities to do with little ones all day!

INFANT B

6 - 12 months

As your infant continues to grow, even a 6-month difference is a developmental significance! Our infants are starting to move a lot more, teachers read more stories, and infants explore and play while they learn!

INFANT C

12 - 18 months

At this stage, infants are walking and exploring the world around them in a whole new way! The nursery becomes a classroom where lessons and curriculum become more familiar.



TODDLERS

18 - 24 months

Toddlers are beginning to communicate verbally, and we begin teaching non-verbal communication skills like sign language.



TWO

24 - 36 months

As your toddler becomes a two-year-old, they begin to improve their verbal communication skills as they learn the alphabet, counting and other core skills necessary for development.

THREE


36 - 48 months

The threes program promotes your child's interest for learning. Children have a chance to develop their social and communication skills through activities and friendships. Shapes & figures, Spanish classes, outdoor play, reading stories, arts & crafts, dressing up, counting, sensorial activities, block-building activities are all introduced.

PRE-K

4 - 5 years

SCHOOL-AGE

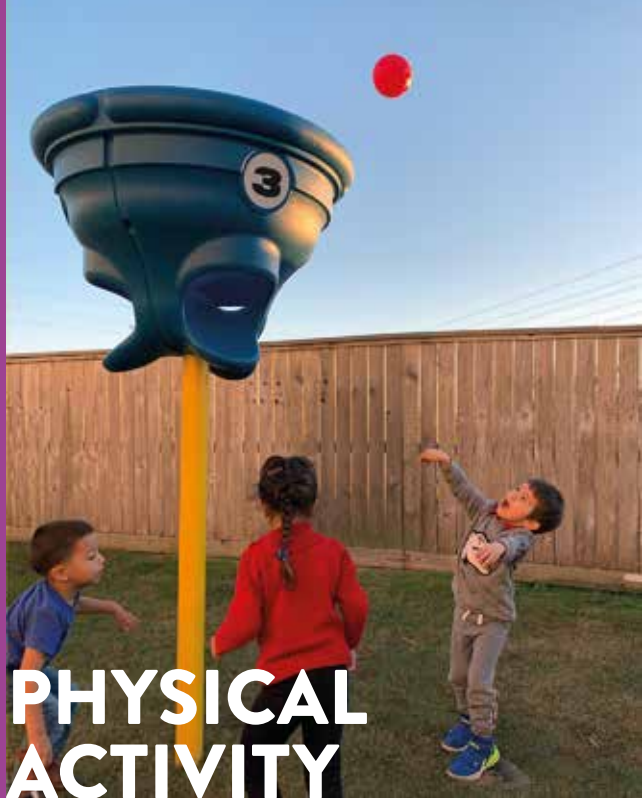
6 - 12 years
