

MY PLACE PROCEDURE

During these uncertain times, we maintain our unwavering commitment to ensure the health and safety of our families, children, teams, and our community.

As you may be aware, the county has recommended non-essential business to either implement new guidelines or temporarily close their doors to mitigate and reduce speed of virus transmission.

Nurseries, daycares, and pre-schools have been deemed a critical infrastructure by the CDC and White House and, as such, we are committed to keeping our campuses open for as long as we are allowed by local authorities. Many of our parents need us for childcare just as our community needs them to continue their important work. We will continue to support our families and community.

We are taking every possible step to ensure that we provide a safe and sanitized environment for our children. These include (but not limited to):

- A strict regimen of disinfection of the facility and items in the building (like toys).
- No adults allowed in the building at drop-off/pick-up. We will escort children at the door.
- All who enter our doors are scanned for temperature. Any with a 100.4° or higher is not allowed in the building.
- Any student with signs or symptoms of respiratory issues (cough, wheezing, shortness of breath) not permitted to attend.

SCHOOL ADMITTANCE AND SCREENING PROCEDURES FOR STAFF:

- Prior to entering the school, every staff member must be screened for illness.
- While engaging in screening procedures, the person conducting the screening must either be wearing a mask, face shield, and gloves. In addition, before each new screening has begun, the thermometer must be disinfected.
- For each person who has been screened, documentation of the screening must be recorded using a Health Screening Log.
- The front door of the school will be propped open during this time to allow for social distancing of 6 feet between staff as they enter and are screened.

Taking these steps will ensure that parents can drop off their children with confidence that they are and will continue to be safe.
